Misconceptions and providing flexibilities/candidate focus (20 minutes)

- Can student teachers be paid as substitutes?
 - Yes they could be paid the whole time as substitute teachers
 - Check out residency program (NMU,WSU and SVSU)
- Can we grant credit from prior learning/testing
 - Yes
 - Going away from credit requirements to program of study
 - CLEP/Dante/Transfer CAEL protocols.
 - Adding endorsement not credit hour etc. requirement. Other ways to do this.
- Administrator certificate many places have enrollment deadlines that makes it hard for administrators to get enrolled. (Application deadline Dec 15, person gets admin job in March. Can't get into program)
- Can I do this additional endorsement program online for an out of state program.
 - Yes but whv.
 - Can't approve out of state programs. Candidate does the program that leads to credential in that state and then apply to State and hope it transfers.
 - MDE approves a course of study, EPPs can offer in variety of ways.
 - o EPP can use a variety of ways to meet the needs of the students looking at these alt. Ways
- Help! I need reading diagnostics class now and can't enroll anywhere.

- Consider expanding offerings.
- Know the season's when teachers looking for this.
- Always a bill to get rid of this requirement, but it doesn't seem to get traction
- Requests come June 1st to June 30th.
- Consider allowing others to student teach.
 - Question: How do you count student teaching at your institution.
- QUESTION: How does someone who subs in student teaching get mentored?
 - Answer: Doesn't look like student teaching. They are the instructor of record going right in and they have mentors on faculty of school and supervisor. Example: SVSU had 100 applicants right off the bat. (More than other alt route combined)

 - Admin from very small schools had the most resistance
 - Staffing
 - What didn't hear that they against the preparation in the new way. Appropriate placement part of the conversation. Need quality teachers.
- Next Steps for implementation of new cert. Implementation
 - <Messy graphic on screen making no sense from looking at it on a slide and hard to read.
 Lots of stuff.> Feedback complex.
 - Need to take feedback info back to MDE and stakeholders.
 - How to getting letters of support from stakeholder groups.
 - Communicate final decisions.
 - Update standards and programs
 - Earliest possible would be candidates existing in 2024.
 - Will need to update assessments etc.
- Question: Where does special education fall into this.
 - Special ed will remain K-12 and categorical
 - One track for prek-3, 3-6. Option 1 and 2 going away. One program. Do not know about ZS yet. Will sit on prek-3 or 3-6.
 - OPP does not have control of special education. We have to lobby for change with special education at MDE.
- How will existing certificates be converted etc?
 - No plan to convert at the moment. Grandfather. AG said we will have to give people
 opportunities or time. Don't yet have a plan. Discussed possibilities of add on for
 specialization.
- Don't want to replicate what we have now. How do we do this.

They have heard us. Other states are talking to them. MDE doesn't know what will happen.
 - MDE did ask if we can help CAEP more. MDE isn't getting information. Asked CAEP to share information with states prior to release.
 - Other states have same concerns as we do it appears at the state meetings.

Discussion: No more switching - IB or SI. New CAEP will be SI with continue

Going forward - Program review with feedback for elementary will need data like old SPA reports for elementary. Unit level and elementary level alone. This is a real concern going forward. Not really know

what is going on with program review with feedback. Team doesn't have capacity for content specific program review with feedback.

Certification Officers - Albion Room

- MTTC: Can we get scores electronically through Results Analyzer for official electronic scores for content area tests?
 - Steve: contacted ES and they are working on how to get it to you on a secure entry site at the education reports.net site.
- SAT: we have not had the MDE institutional code until recently. Is it for all? Is it a good "fail safe"?
 - Steve: yes, but still keep through EPI's b/c MDE won't see it at all unless it has the 6962.
 - Good idea to have it as a fail safe...
 - If it ends up being the route, please continue to have them send it to you and then you put it into MOECS for now.
 - Are their checkmarks in place in high schools for SAT submission to EPI's
 - Might be a year before SAT will talk to MOECS and not call it an alt scoring
 - Issues surrounding SAT, including issues with access to high school testing sites, send all questions to Steve as we move forward. Ex: how do we increase testing sites for our students, what about non-trads who have issues taking a test at a high school site. Df
 - Steve: considering GRE for grad students. Trouble is CAEP has done equivalencies and there
 is such a difference in sample populations for GRE vs SAT... Sean said it is on Steve's plate
 and we'll leave it at that.
- Transition period; how does it impact our current grads
 - First stage is to get it changed from provisional to standard. Benefit is there is unlimited renewals. No more 1st, 2nd ...now just renewals
 - New people coming up: if it is approved our December grads will be receiving the "standard", not provisional cert.

- CPR question came up about "official" document: Sean directed them to Beatrice Harrison.
- Expired certs: nothing new to those. They will say Standard as they renew, as well as changing the wording on existing certs.
- Sean: to renew your Standard has not changed.
- Sean said all communication about changes on November 2nd will go out through DARTEP.
- Question: has anybody had a paid student teacher? Yes...discussion followed...no MDE permission needed...once a sub permit in order they qualify

Update on MI Dean's Council Fall Retreat meeting:

- -Built a pros and cons list for participating in CAEP (same issues as others have identified)
- -Gave list to MACTE president for Nov. 3 meeting with Chris Koch
- -High Needs areas and programs with low enrollment. Identify our respective programs and think of ways EPIs can collaborate to deliver content prep
- -Hot Topics in state of Michigan similar to process used at Day on the Hill (AACTE)
- -Leah Breen gave legislative updates and prioritized list for teacher prep

Update on MACTE Board meeting:

- -Teachers for Tomorrow and questions: advertising, setting up appts. With Superintendents as a way to meet district needs. 5 year preliminary approval.
- -How to get information to our legislators. NMU has a system involving student workers Alumni Board, Board of Trustees, etc. to get "good news" stories out, give talking points. Student workers call legislators once a week "this is what I did, it

was great practice for me and I'm excited about this and I just wanted you to know." ST call representatives in their own district and tell them why they chose this EPI.

Information (Kelli & Vic, MDE) re Rule 1280c;

Were identifying schools for bottom 5%; SRO sent letters to 10 districts to close 30+ schools; created uproar; neogotiated with governor; these are our "partnership" schools. 9 of 10 now have agreements (10 was charter which closed)

District-level work, but tough because districts are where they are because a school(s) were identified.

MDE: Work is to knock-down barriers to districts achieving their goals (somewhat like Corrective Action):

Preston Hicks(MDE): Want to hear challenges you are working through? We would live to hear

Q: Subbing policies, drawing from the residency discussion this morning. What are EPI policies?

Aquinas: Last two weeks of paid . There is a form and process. Using ST process to "try out" long-term subs for future term, etc.

GVSU: Lot of early requests. We have a mentorship/support agreement

???: Only sub for their menor. At least two weeks into ST'ing. No more than 15 days.

Have to be certified to sub via the subbing agency. IF a sub does show up, and ST asked, then ST stay in placement room, and mentor teacher go sub in that classroom.

Also wanting STs to proctor high-stakes testing. We do not allow that

MDE (Kelli): Our challenge is university faculty saying they have not heard about certification structure. How can we spread the information about this beyond DARTEP participants to their wider institutional faculty, etc.

EPI: The faculty won't look at MDE website or updates;

EPI:: ot sure when is right time to share, during development; after official policy, etc. Maybe some guidance from MDE

Q: (Preston, MDE): Do we have in the state of MI do we have practices that are of quality with which we could have national conversations. How effective are we compared to other states, colleagues, etc. Not sure you know how good you are. How do we capture what you are doing?

EPI: Graduates get multiple out-of-state teaching offers

EPI: I think our graduates are better now than ever; better than they were 10-15 years ago. Current middle of the road better than outstanding 10-15 years ago. Not sure to measure that

Preston: On a parents committee about schools; how do we convey to them how well our teachers are prepared. Opportunity/challenge for us is how to be the EPIs of choice within our states and Michigan as a state of choice

EPI: Graduate employment in other states; could survey graduates about how they feel compared to their peers educated in that state

Adrian or Albion: We wanted to determine teacher quality; We did a simulation of them being STs and supervisors so they can start to think about what quality teaching really looks like.

UM-Dearborn: Faculty chose Danielson Framework and infused the 4 domains in everything and tracking what it looks like, and teacher candidates know how they will be evaluated in-service; de-mystifies it.

Q (WMU): New director of field experiences (Jen). Have to apply for SCECHs for mentor teachers. Wasn't familiar with process. Submitted application. MTs not getting them for this semester. If you have any forms to share, I would appreciate that
