The Michigan Department of Education (MDE) has determined that verification of a teacher's No Child Left Behind Highly Qualified status is no longer required. Michigan law still requires teachers to be appropriately certified and endorsed for their assignment. Please see your DARTEP Update for more details.




Clinical Experiences and Core Practices were presented to the State Board of Education on September 11, 2019.

These requirements and practices are to be incorporated into programs created for the new certificate structure beginning with the PK-3 and 3-6 grade band programs.



Teacher Leader programs are considered designations, not endorsements and are not subject to CAEP accreditation requirements.







#### TEACHER CERTIFICATION RESTRUCTURE DIAGRAM



Effective February 6, 2020 there will be specific professional development criteria needed to renew a school counselor credential. Renewal requirements are aligned with the new School Counselor Professional Development Standards linked to MCL 380.1233 (7-9).
