
Clinical Experiences and Core Practices were presented to the State Board of Education on September 11, 2019.





Teacher Leader programs are considered designations, not endorsements and are **not subject to CAEP accreditation requirements.**



Ann Green, new data analyst in the Office of Educator Excellence. Ann will be providing data analysis and reporting services that support the use of staffing data for business and technical users.




DID YOU KNOW...

Last Updated 2-5-18



## DID YOU KNOW...

Effective February 6, 2020 there will be specific professional development criteria needed to renew a school counselor credential. Renewal requirements are aligned with the new School Counselor Professional Development Standards linked to MCL 380.1233 (7-9).
