CAEP UPDATE

- Accreditation for Advanced Programs
 - Required in Fall 2019 (Spring Self-Study Reports)
 - Plans and some data are expected
 - Spring 2019 EPPs will need to choose:
 - Let advanced program accreditation lapse
 - Complete an advanced program self study process in two years
- **Advanced Programs: Administrator, Reading Specialist, School Psychologist, School Counselor, School Social Worker, Special Education Administrator**

CAEP UPDATE

- CAEP Policy 5.10
 - **An EPP** that has secured specialty area accreditation from a specialized accrediting agency recognized by the U.S. Secretary of Education or CHEA **can choose** to have such program(s) exempted from review by CAEP.
 - Includes CACREP and APA
 - List on CAEP website

CAEP Elementary Standards

Michigan EPPs must use Michigan Elementary Standards

Can crosswalk to CAEP if desired



State Program Review

EPPs submit 3 months prior to SSR due date

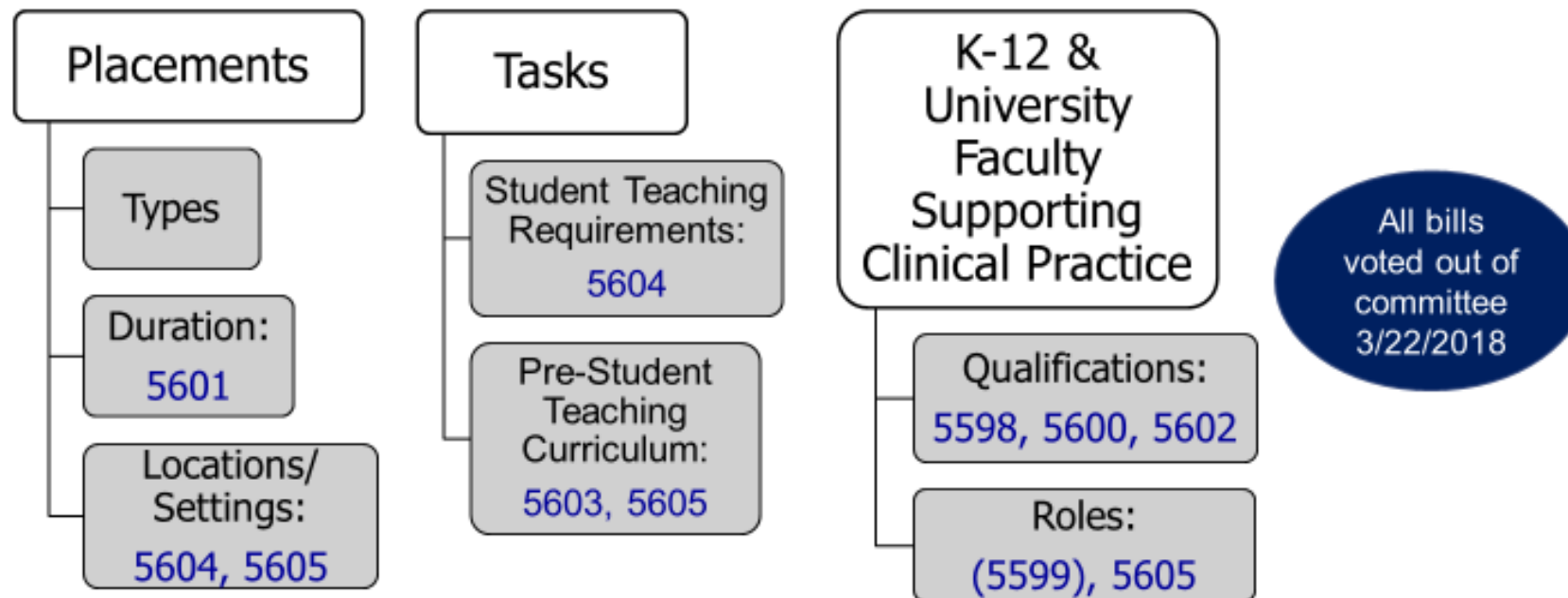

Teacher Preparation Bill Package (Garcia, et al.)



ALSO STILL OUT THERE...

Basic Skills Exam (BSE) & Reading Diagnostics

SB 727: Eliminates
BSE for Alternative
Routes

Signed into law April 5, 2018

HB 4084: Eliminates
Reading Diagnostics

Passed House and Senate
Committee 6/6/18

SB 889: Eliminates
BSE for Traditional
Routes

Signed into law June 26, 2018

HB 5707, HB 6401: EDUCATOR AND ADMINISTRATOR EVALUATION

- Freeze student growth percentage in Educator and Administrator Evaluations at 25%
- Passed House Ed Reform Committee 10/4/18

HB 4421 – SUBSTITUTE TEACHERS

- 60/90 credits OR diploma with professional license
- Sub S-3 reported – not online (S-2 had age exemption)
- Passed the House. Passed Senate Ed Committee 11/27, heading to Senate floor.

HB 5543 – STUDENT TEACHERS

- Require a background check
- Referred to House Education Reform Committee
2/13/2018
- On Committee agenda 11/29/2018

SB 1186 - GSRP

- Revise to allow participation by 3-year-olds
- Introduced 11/8/2018
- Referred to Committee on Appropriations



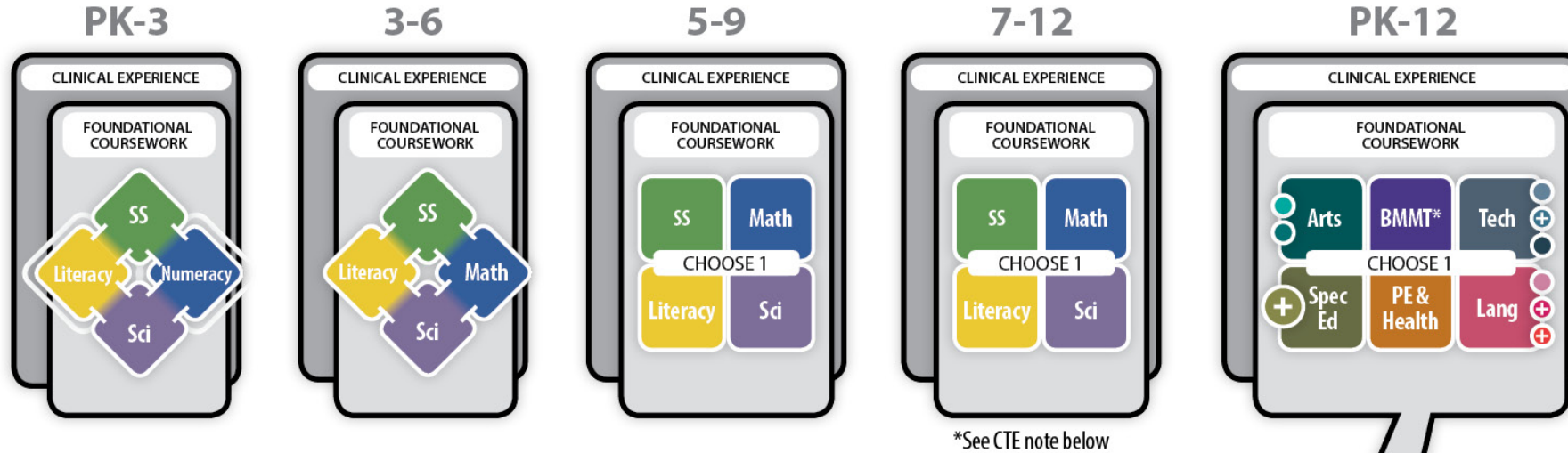
HIGH LEVERAGE TEACHING PRACTICES

TEACHER CERTIFICATION RESTRUCTURE DIAGRAM

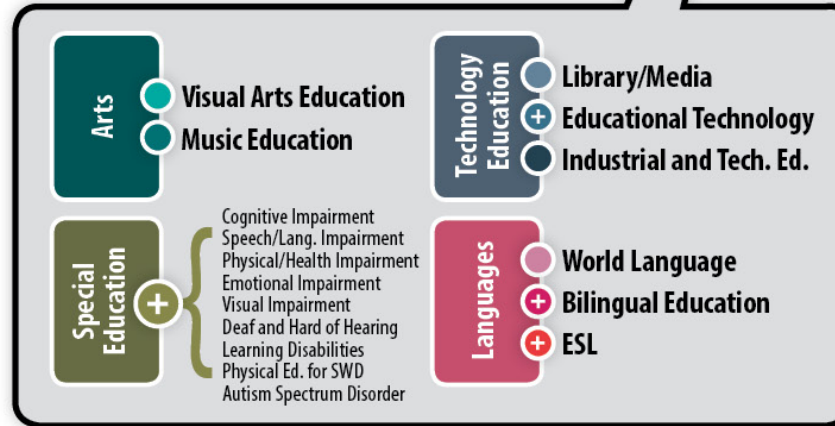

- Social-Emotional Competence
- Early and Ongoing Clinical Experiences
- Educational Technology
- Interaction with Special Populations of Students
- Needs of Diverse Learners and Cultural Competence
- Emphasis on Content-Specific Pedagogy
- Learner-Centered Supports
- Assessment Literacy

3. Clarified inclusion of movement, arts, and healthy living

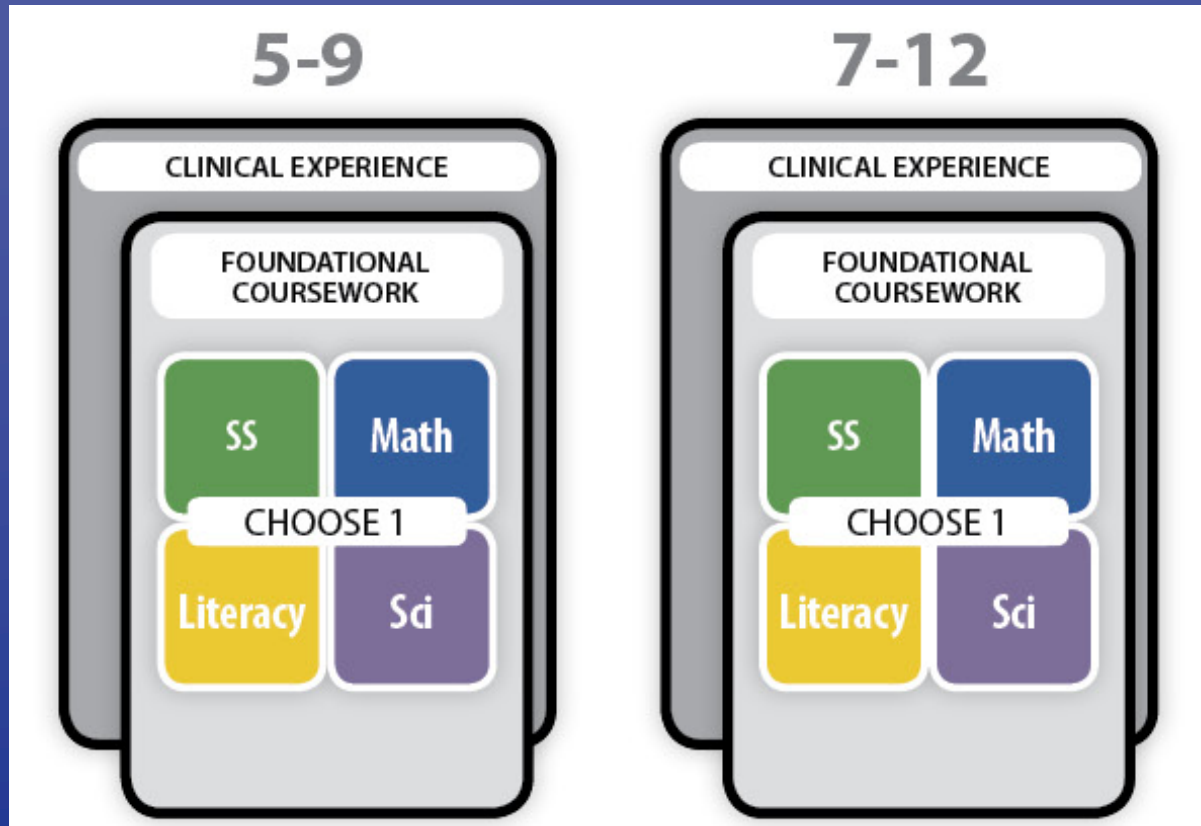

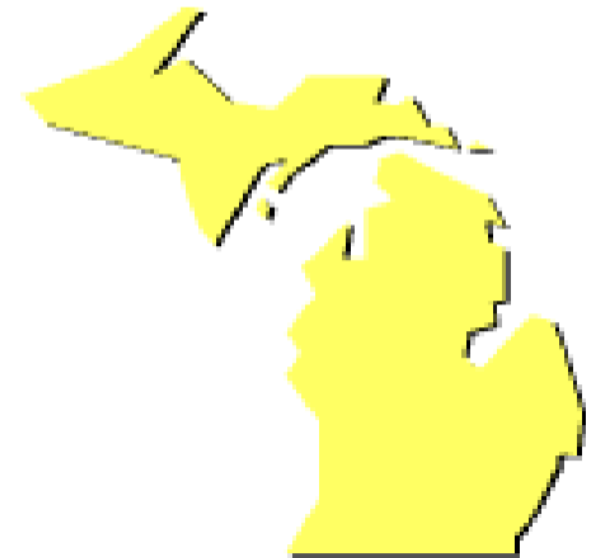
