The Michigan Department of Education (MDE) has determined that verification of a teacher's No Child Left Behind Highly Qualified status is no longer required. **Michigan law still requires teachers to be appropriately certified and endorsed for their assignment.**

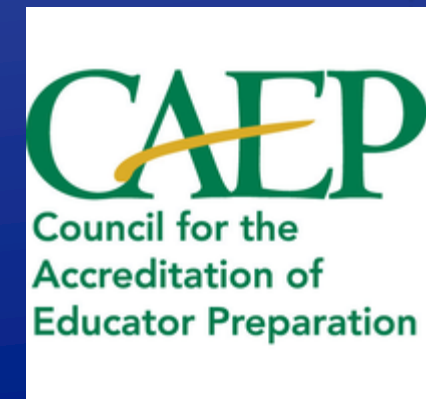
Clinical Experiences and Core Practices were presented to the State Board of Education on September 11, 2019.

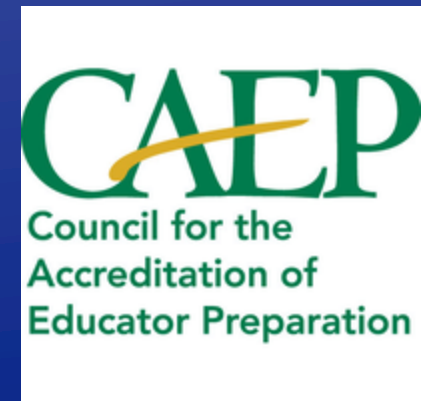

OEE has released a new report titled 2018 Annual Report Metrics that includes commonly requested data about the educator pipeline.



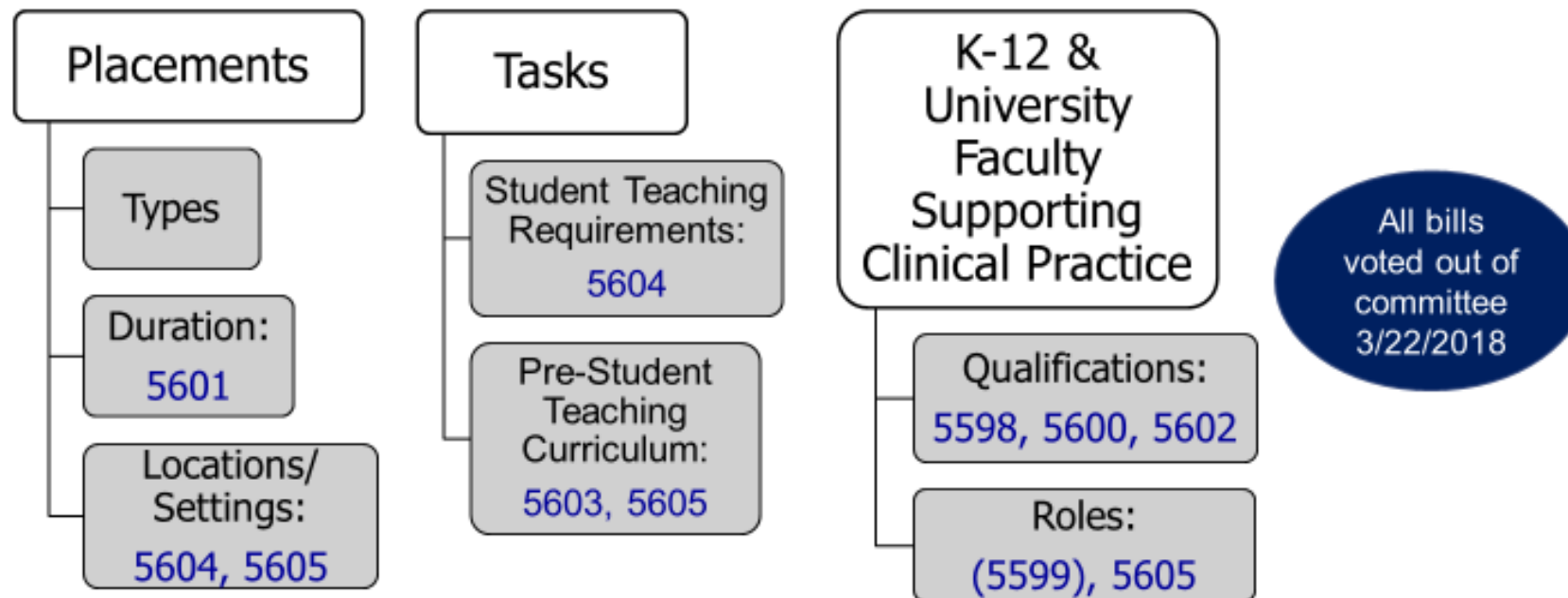

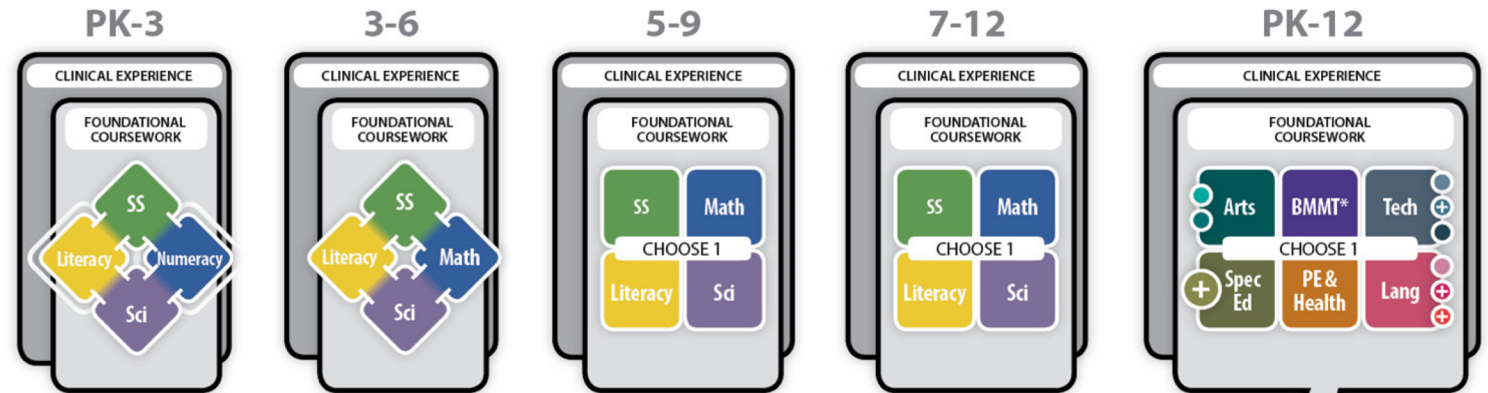
Teacher Leader programs are considered designations, not endorsements and are **not subject to CAEP accreditation requirements.**

Last Updated 2-5-18

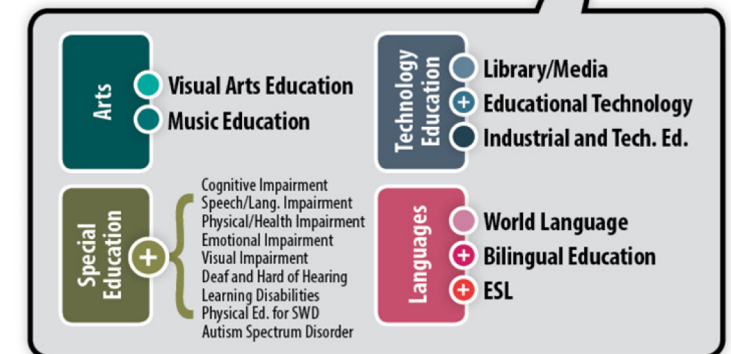

+ Indicates a preparation program that must be paired with core content area

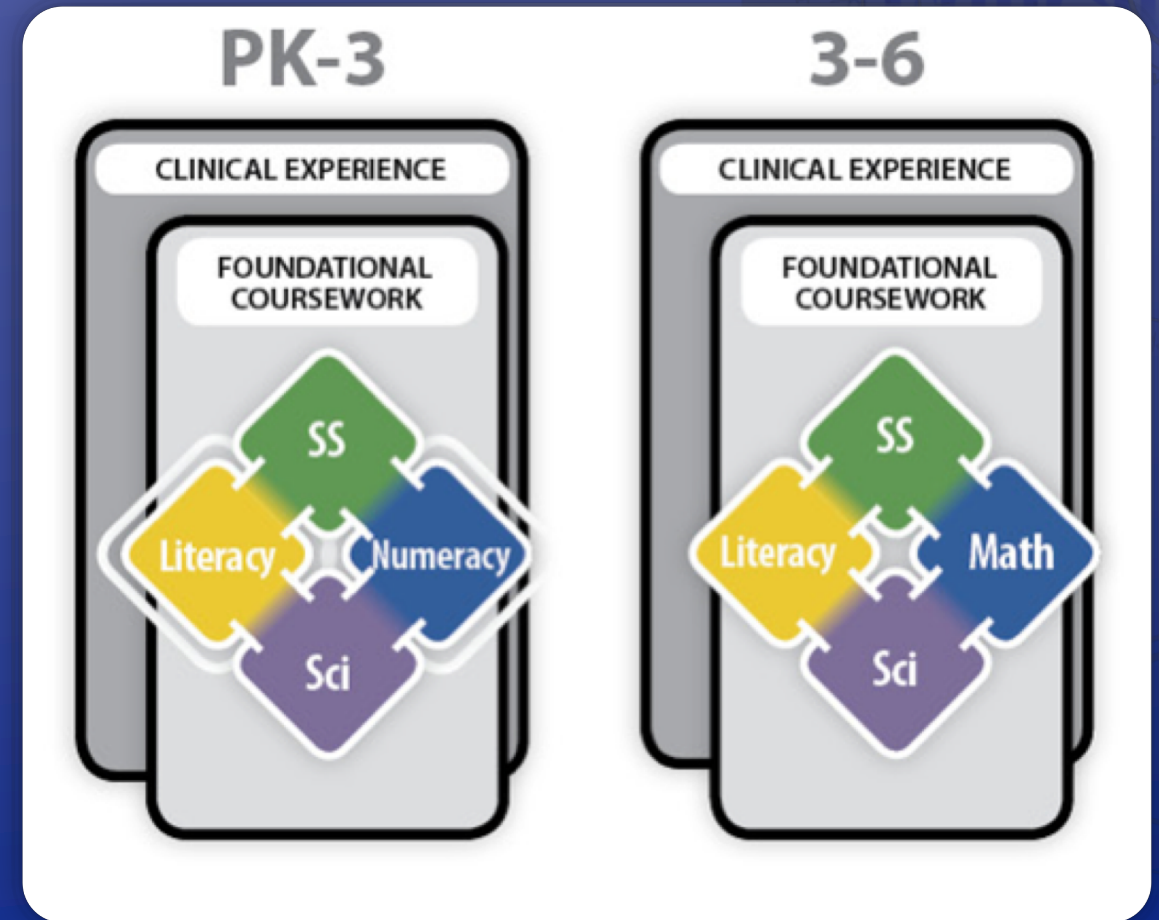

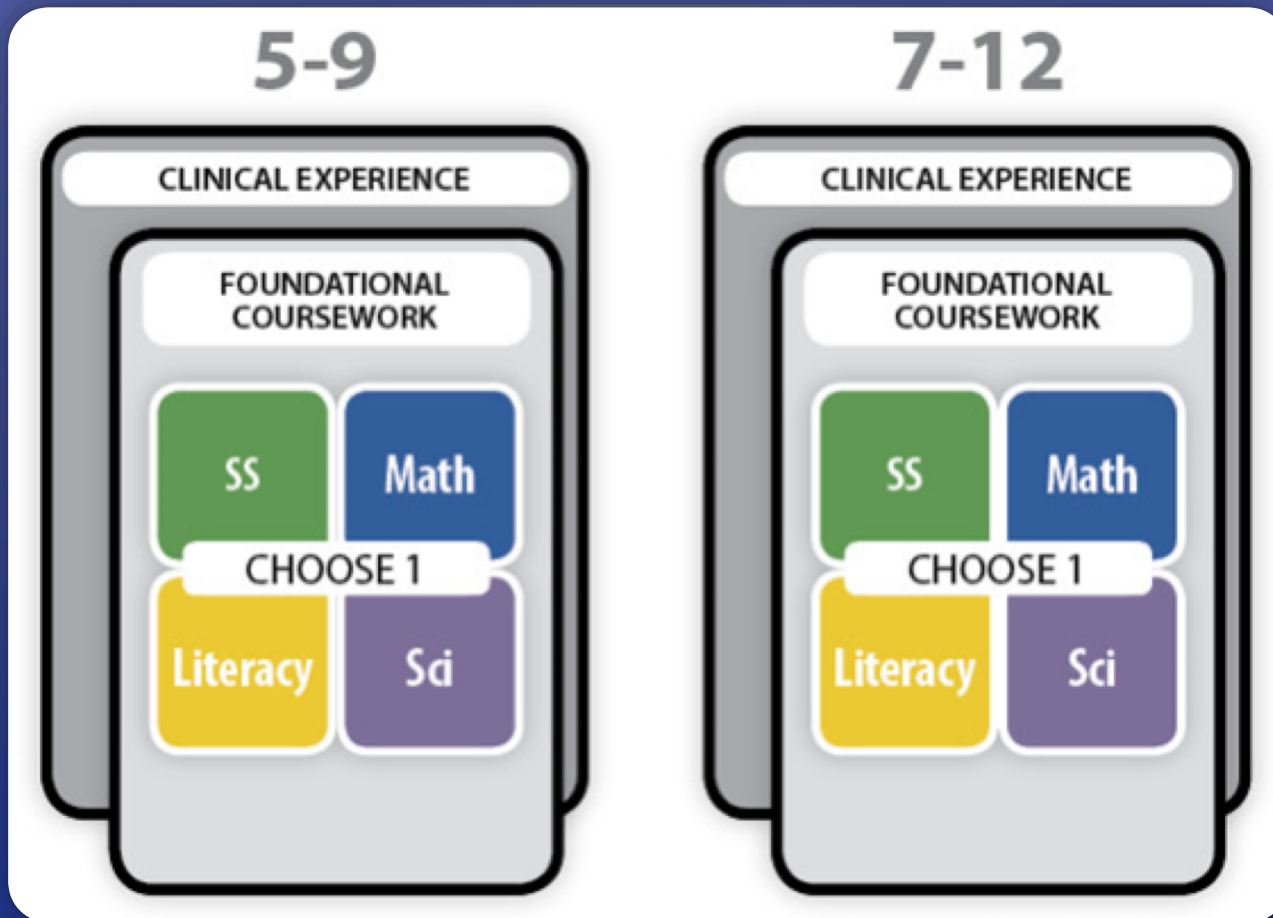
