The Michigan Department of Education (MDE) has determined that verification of a teacher's No Child Left Behind Highly Qualified status is no longer required. Michigan law still requires teachers to be appropriately certified and endorsed for their assignment.

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
### DID YOU KNOW...

These requirements and practices are to be incorporated into programs created for the new certificate structure beginning with the PK-3 and 3-6 grade band programs.



OEE has released a new report titled 2018 Annual Report Metrics that includes commonly requested data about the educator pipeline.








The teacher certification structure will be implemented in phases.

#### TEACHER CERTIFICATION RESTRUCTURE DIAGRAM Last Updated 2-5-18




