
The Office of Professional Preparation Services (OPPS) is now called the Office of Educator Excellence (OEE).




Clinical Experiences and Core Practices were presented to the State Board of Education on September 11, 2019.



The teacher certification structure will be implemented in phases.


TEACHER CERTIFICATION RESTRUCTURE DIAGRAM






PROGRAM COMPONENTS



Indicates a preparation program that must be paired with core content area


NOTE: Career and Technical Education (CTE) endorsements will remain valid for grades 9-12 and Classification of Instructional Programs (CIP) codes will not change.








Teams are currently meeting to review and revise the 5-9 and 7-12 literacy and mathematics endorsement standards.
