## **MEMO #003-21** – Future Proud Michigan Educator Development Grant (January 11, 2021)

Good news! As a continuation of Michigan's efforts to grow and diversify the educator workforce and reduce educator shortages, MDE is launching the **Future Proud Michigan Educator (Future PME) initiative** with a competitive grant for school districts to develop programs for students interested in the teaching profession.

### MEMO #119-20 - 2021-22 Teacher Shortage Areas for Loan Forgiveness (December 17, 2020)

On December 11, 2020, MDE provided the U.S. Department of Education (USED) with a list of **educator shortage areas** in Michigan. This list was developed according to federal regulations and supports new teachers and teachers with student loans in obtaining targeted loan forgiveness or deferment.

#### MEMO #COVID-19-124 - Spring 2021 State Assessments (December 8, 2020)

Though a requirement of federal and state law to administer **statewide assessments** every year, MDE will again be seeking a waiver of the federal requirement to administer the spring 2021 assessments due to the enduring pandemic. I shared this continued commitment at today's State Board of Education meeting.

#### MEMO #113-20 – 2021 CTE Program Excellence in Practice Awards

The MDE Office of Career and Technical Education (OCTE) is accepting nominations for the **2021 Excellence in Practice Awards** to be presented during the OCTE spring update on Wednesday, April 21, 2021. At this time, the event is scheduled to take place in Grand Rapids, pending the status of the pandemic.

#### SECTION III: Office of Educator Excellence Updates

#### 1. Accreditation Updates

CAEP is soliciting public comment on proposed revisions to the CAEP Advanced Standards for Educator Preparation. A note to consider is although CAEP Standard 3.2 removed all mention of standardized testing, Standard A3.2 still mentions it as an

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option. Public comment will be accepted through March 1, 2021. If standards are approved, they will go into effect during the Fall 2022 semester. Click here to access CAEP's public comment page.

#### 2. <u>Ed Prep 101</u>

OEE is developing a systematic approach to providing technical assistance for educator preparation programs. Broadly grouped under the title of Ed Prep 101, the goal is to support EPPs in onboarding new staff, introducing and updating program requirements, and addressing candidate concerns. Separate strands will be available for target audiences, at both traditional and alternate route providers, including teacher certification officers, program directors, accreditation coordinators, deans, advisors, faculty, and others. The project team is currently soliciting suggestions as to key materials and resources, and optimal delivery formats. #### 3. EPI Performance Management System

The proposal to revise Michigan's EPI Performance Score framework was presented to Dr. Rice in January. He approved the team to move forward with implementation! The new methodology will take a phased approach to implementation to ensure new components are sound and accurate before being included within a score. Target initial implementation is 2021-22.

For this year, the Performance Score will be calculated using the methodology in place since 2014. MDE will also send out what each provider's score would look like with the new methodology.

#### **Next Steps:**

- February 2021: OEE will provide a "data dump" of relevant certification, employment, and survey data to assist with CAEP reporting efforts.
- March 2021: MDE will convene a referent panel to examine the score and determine the appropriate threshold for satisfactory performance in a given year.
   Note: An email requesting nominations for participation in the panel went out this week to deans and directors.
- May 2021: OEE will hold a webinar to discuss the new methodology and its roll out.

#### 5. Paid Internships & Waiving Student Teaching

In August 2020, the Michigan Department of Education (MDE) released the memorandum "Supporting Hard-to-Fill Positions with Teaching Candidates." This memo to local and intermediate school district superintendents and to public school academy directors highlights the advantage that candidates enrolled in teacher preparation programs offer to schools over individuals with no training or teaching experience. As candidates need to complete clinical experience requirements throughout their program, including a final internship, MDE recognizes the potential for synergy that paid service can offer to PK-12 and teacher candidates. EPPs are also reminded that R 390.1123(1)(b)(iv) allows for waiver of the student teaching experience for individuals who have taught successfully for three to five years. MDE encourages educator preparation institutions to collaborate with local education agencies to support paraprofessionals, substitute teachers, and other noncertified personnel working in districts who wish to earn educator certification in an expedited manner. This provision of the Teacher Certification Code provides a flexibility to help with this process.

## 3. <u>Grade Band Implementation Timeline: Early Childhood General and Special Education (Birth-Kindergarten)</u>

The timeline for implementation of the Early Childhood General and Special Education grade bands is as follows:

- Program applications due: November 30, 2020; April 30, 2021; or November 30, 2021
- Program review: November 2020 March 2021, May 2021 September 2021, November 2021 – March 2022
- First enrollment into B-K programs: Fall 2021

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- B-K MTTCs projected to become operational: 2022
- Final offering of MTTC #106: 2026

## 4. <u>Grade Band Implementation Timeline: Lower Elementary (PK-3) and Upper Elementary (3-6)</u>

The timeline for implementation of the PK-3 and 3-6 grade bands was updated in a memo dated June 23, 2020.

- Program applications due: November 30, 2020; April 30, 2021; or November 30, 2021
- Program review: November 2020 March 2021, May 2021 September 2021, November 2021 – March 2022
- First enrollment into PK-3/3-6 programs: Fall 2021
- PK-3/3-6 MTTCs projected to become operational: October/November 2021
- Final offering of MTTC #103: July 2026

## 5. <u>Presidential Awards for Excellence in Mathematics and Science Teaching (PAEMST)</u>

We are always looking for individuals with deep content and pedagogical knowledge of STEM content for grades K-12 to serve as program mentors and reviewers. Stipends are available for mentors and reviewers and are calculated based on time spent assisting in each role. #### 6. Reciprocity Support for Candidates

Certificate reciprocity between states is a regularly discussed topic with all MDE's state agency counterparts and the National Association of State Directors of Teacher Education and Certification (NASDTEC). A recent webinar series presented by NASDTEC shared a resource (available online at

https://education.uky.edu/accreditation/certification/states/) designed to help certification officers and colleges of education support their teacher candidates wherever they choose to start their careers. OEE strongly encourages teacher candidates to obtain their Michigan teaching certificate even if they are choosing certification in another state.

## 7. <u>Standards: Middle Level (5-9) and High School (7-12) English Language Arts, Mathematics, and Professional</u>

Implementation Timeline:

- Program applications due: November 30, 2021, April 30, 2022, or November 30, 2022
- Program review: December 2021 March 2022, May 2022 September 2022, December 2022 – March 2023
- First enrollment into programs: Fall 2023
- Professional, ELA, and Math MTTCs projected to become operational: 2023
- Final offering of MTTCs #085, 090, 002, 089 and 022: 2029

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#### 8. Standards: Special Education Supervisor and Director

The Standards for the Preparation and Practice of Special Education Administrators were approved by the State Board of Education on March 10, 2020. Program submission and review is postponed until November 2021 to align with the first anticipated submissions of revised administrator preparation programs. Current special education director and supervisor preparation programs as well as proposed special education administrator programs are required to submit/resubmit for review and approval. Special education director and supervisor programs should continue to align with competencies identified in MARSE. Please contact Sungti Hsu (HsuS@Michigan.gov) if you have any questions or are interested in submitting a program for approval. Sungti will send you an Intent to Submit Program Form so that your program is on record.
