





Key Legislative Updates – Signed into Law



- Public Act 15 of 2021 (formerly SB 118) reduce salary deduction for noncertified teachers if the district comes into compliance within 10 days of notification
- State School Aid Act \$240,000,000 allocated to districts for increasing the number of school psychologists, school social workers, school counselors, and school nurses




