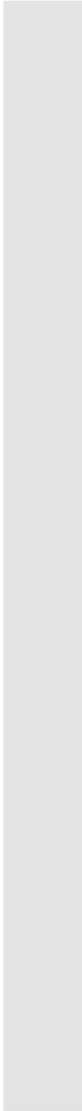

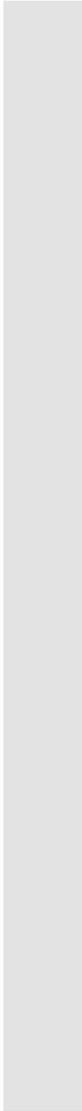

MI Future Educator Fellowship

The MI Future Educator Fellowship will offer \$10,000 scholarship to up to 2,500 **future educators** every year.

High school graduates must be admitted to an eligible educator preparation program and begin their first semester or term in Fall 2022 or after. Additional eligibility requirements apply.

MI Future Educator Student Teacher Stipend

The MI Future Educator Student Teacher Stipend is a program to support Michigan's hardworking **student teachers** as they continue their journey to being in the classroom full-time.

Up to \$9,600 per semester will be available for use towards allowable student teaching expenses (tuition, living expenses, childcare, etc.).

- GYO Grants to individually nominated educators for attendance at Michigan EPIs
- Prioritized endorsements in special education, English as a second language, or bilingual education
- Preferred candidates had completed 50% or more of their programs upon application (March, 2022)

- 158 teachers funded
 - Across all 9 prosperity regions
 - Across 107 different LEAs, PSAs or ISDs
- 27 Educator Preparation Providers
- Average funding request per awardee: \$6,326
- 34 grantees have earned the new endorsement or certification (as of 1/10/23)

- GYO Grants to LEAs, PSAs and ISDs to address staffing shortages
- Driven by locally defined need
- Requires partnership with degree-granting Michigan EPPs
- For candidates enrolled between March, 2021 and December, 2026

- Application review complete
- 129 applications processed
- Federal guidelines: 3 reviewers/application
- Many applications contained errors
- EPP agreements must be complete (include 7 components and fully signed by both parties)
- May award announcement
- Second round likely
- Assign point person over summer months

Project OPTIMISE: <https://optimise.education/>

represents work completed by the 94d Task Force around special education recruitment, preparation, and retention.

1. The Task Force has recommended Michigan provide a pathway to initial special education certification that is stand alone.
2. The Task Force has also recommended Michigan create a Special Education Teacher endorsement that allows special educators to work across placement needs in a school or district and serve all special education students.

Work on revising the Michigan Administrative Rules for Special Education will occur simultaneously on the above processes with revisions supporting the above recommendation.


