

# Office of Educator Excellence DARTEP Update May 9, 2025

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# SECTION I: Legislative Updates

Below is a selection of bills currently (as of April 28, 2025) before the Michigan Senate and the House of Representative. This selection is limited to educator workforce related bills with activity since the <a href="February">February</a>, 7 2025 DARTEP update. #### **Introduced Bills**

- **HB 4228** school safety and security training. Introduced 3/12/2025, referred to Education and Workforce committee.
- HB 4286 Modifies health education standards and guidelines to include instruction on human development. Introduced 3/26/2025, referred to Education and Workforce committee.

# **Moving Bills**

- **SB 83** MI Future Educator Student Teaching Stipends. Passed the Senate 3/19/2025 and onto the House (Government Operations Committee).
- **HB 4150** elimination of certificate application fees. Passed the House 3/12/2025 and onto the Senate (Education committee).
- **HB 4151** modifying endorsement requirements for teachers and administrators. Passed the House 3/12/2025 and onto the Senate (Education committee).

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- **HB 4152** requirements for the approval of teacher preparation institutions. Reported out of Education and Workforce committee 3/5/2025. Requires House vote to move.
- **HB 4153** district-level certifications for teachers and administrators; includes a sunset. Passed the House 3/12/2025 and onto the Senate (Education committee).
- **HB 4154** regarding career and technical education. Passed the House and onto the Senate.
- **HB 4227** requires ISDs to employ at least one emergency and safety manager and at least one mental health coordinator. Reported out of Education and Workforce committee 4/16/2025. Requires House vote to move to Senate.
- **HB 4238** grant participation with foreign countries. Reported out of Government Operations committee 3/26/2025. Requires House vote to move to Senate.

#### Fiscal Year 2026 Budget

The Executive Recommendation was put forth by the governor for the Fiscal Year 2026 budget. The Senate appropriations subcommittees have passed SB 165 & 166, for the MDE Budget and PK-12 Budget, respectively. Negotiations continue.

# **Standards Development: Special Education Teacher**

At the May State Board of Education meeting, on 5/13, Dr. Gina Garner and OEE Director Kelli Brozanski will join Nancy Rotarius from the Office of Special Education, our Deputy Superintendent Michele Harmala, and two specially recruited special educators to seek approval for new Special Education Teacher preparation standards. These standards were originally presented to the Board earlier this year and received robust – and robustly

#### Candidate Tracking

Thank you to all the EPPs for using the MOECS tracking system to start the rostering process. EPPs are asked to continue using the system by enrolling all remaining candidates in their programs. Specifically, candidates who will count as a Title II enrollee during the 2024-25 AY year should be in MOECS by June 30, 2025.

**Note:** Candidates enrolled in advanced programs (e.g., administrator, school psychologist, etc.) do not need to be enrolled at this time, but we encourage EPPs to include them as they develop procedures for enrolling all candidates, regardless of program, into the system.

MDE will release a template in July for EPPs to add candidates who were unresponsive to EPP requests to create a MOECS account.

# \*NEW\* Evaluating and Improving Teacher Preparation Programs: A Consensus Report From the National Academy of Education

On May 22 at 2:00 pm, please join the NASTEC Professional Education Committee and the National Academy of Education for *Evaluating and Improving Teacher Preparation Programs: A Consensus Report From the National Academy of Education*; a webinar discussion with Linda Darling-Hammond, of the Learning Policy Institute, Kenneth Zeichner, from University of Washington, Yelena Bailey, from the Minnesota Professional Educator Licensing and Standards Board, and Patrick Halladay, of the University of Vermont. Panelists will discuss the Evaluating and Improving Teacher Preparation Programs consensus report which provides critical, evidence-based recommendations for teacher preparation program (TPP) evaluation and improvement and the systemic changes necessary to improve teaching as a profession. Specifically, the report addresses four groups of recommendations: (1) improving TPP approval and accreditation, (2) enhancing TPP self-study, (3) providing system supports for TPP evaluation, and (4) creating system supports for teacher preparation and teaching.
